### **Bible Memory Verses for the Family**

Part of our personal growth as Christ Followers is to grow in our knowledge and application of the Bible. A great way to do that is to memorize Bible Verses. When you have a verse memorized, then God can bring that to your mind at the right time, and you can apply it to that situation or circumstance.

If you don't know where to start or what Bible verses to memorize with your kids as a family, this memory system is a great place to start.

The verses in this document tend to be concise and clear. It's a great framework to use to memorize Bible verses to help you better understand your relationship with Christ and to apply to different circumstances in your daily life.

Start in a section and begin to work your way through, verse by verse. Write it down on an index card and look at it throughout the week. Set a date as a goal to memorize the verse by and just stay at it. Review the verses you have memorized as you continue to add more. Do it by yourself, or invite others in to do it with you. You can set a time as a family to memorize during breakfast, after school, at bed time, or pick another time that works for you! You may be surprised as to how much they begin to come to mind throughout the day!
