12 Essential Elements of the Gospel

- 1. God is the creator of all things
- 2. God created mankind in his image and likeness for his glory
- 3. Because God created mankind, we are subject to Him and His authority
- 4. Mankind has rebelled against God This is called sin
- 5. Because God is just and has authority, the rebellion of mankind must be punished by death and separation
- 6. God, in his mercy, has created a way for mankind to be free from the punishment of sin, death, and separation
- 7. God, who exists in heaven outside of time and space, made himself known by emptying himself and taking the form of a man, Jesus Christ
- 8. Christ lived a perfect life, fulfilling the requirement that was necessary in order to pay for the sins of others
- 9. Christ's death on the cross acted as a substitute for the death and separation that rightly should fall on us.
- 10. Through his resurrection, 3 days after his death, Christ proved his victory over sin and triumphed over the grave
- 11. By placing our faith in Christ and his sacrifice, turning from our sin, and believing in Him alone as the one who can bring us back into a relationship with God, our sins are forgiven and paid for through Christ's death and resurrection
- 12. Our faith allows us to be reconciled to God immediately and gives us confidence that we no longer reside under the wrath and judgement of God, and this for eternity
