The Ultimate Plus One

- What was the most fun wedding you've ever attended?
- Have you ever been helped or blessed by someone anonymously?

As we continue our journey with Jesus through the Gospel of John, we will see Him perform His first miracle to save the party at a wedding celebration. In the midst of this miracle, Jesus will also give us a "sign" about what He is ultimately here to do.

Read John 2:1-11

- What did Jesus mean when He said "my time has not yet come?"
- Who witnessed Jesus' first miracle? What was their response?
- Jesus demonstrates His power to transform one thing into another. What/who have you seen Jesus transform? How did that impact you?

The jars Jesus uses for the miracle have significance and help us understand this "sign." Not only were they significant in the wedding ceremony, but the origin of their purification goes back to the Old Testament.

Read Exodus 19:10-11, 14

Once you understand what the jars were going to be used for...How does Jesus change the significance of the jars?

Read John 2:10

- How does this statement about Jesus' actions point to the truth of Jesus' promise?
- What is something Jesus has transformed in you?
- What is one thing you would like Jesus to transform in your life?
