We moved to Brazoria County in 2013. What we didn't know is that our move would be such a huge part of God's plan in our life. In 2016, we attended Brazos Pointe Fellowship with some friends. I think about the transformation God did in our lives, since being Christ followers and my desire for others to experience that. I thought about how six years ago we were trying to look for a church to attend there and how God had presented a new dream of helping start a church in the same area. While we don't know what God's timing is for the dream he put upon our hearts, we know our next step as a family will be to help in any way we can with planting The Pointe Church in Seattle. What originally seemed like a missed opportunity, is now clearly seen as God working in His timing. He showed up, time and again through the trials we faced here. We want to help others see that light as well. We look forward to helping 'The Pointe Church' spread the Good News of Jesus in a way many have never heard before. We continue to pray to be the hands and feet of Jesus and look forward to the plans that God has for us.
